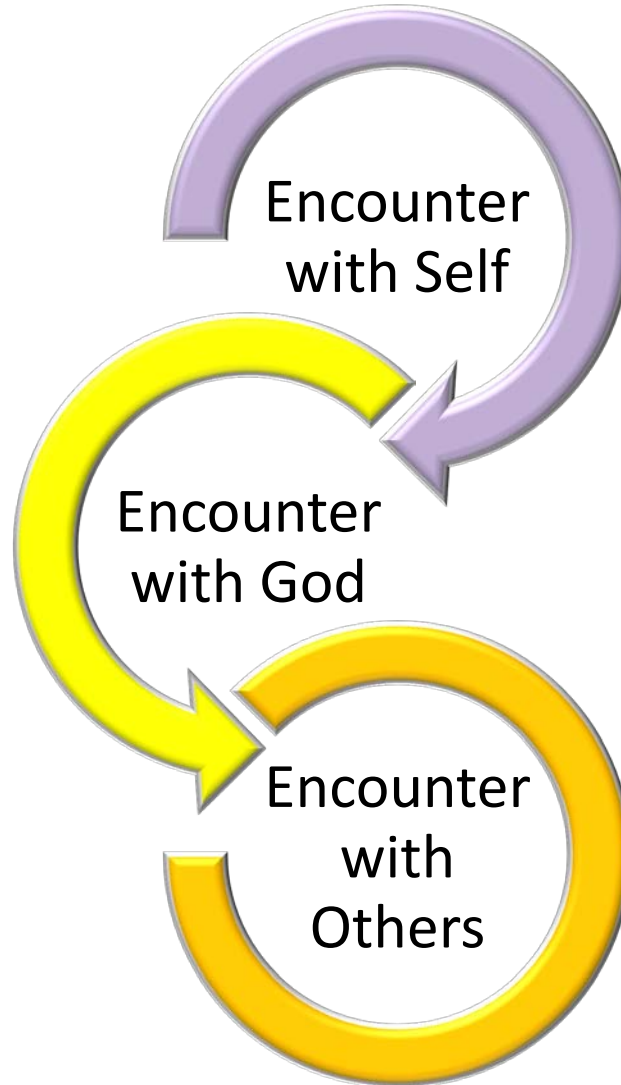
# Introduction

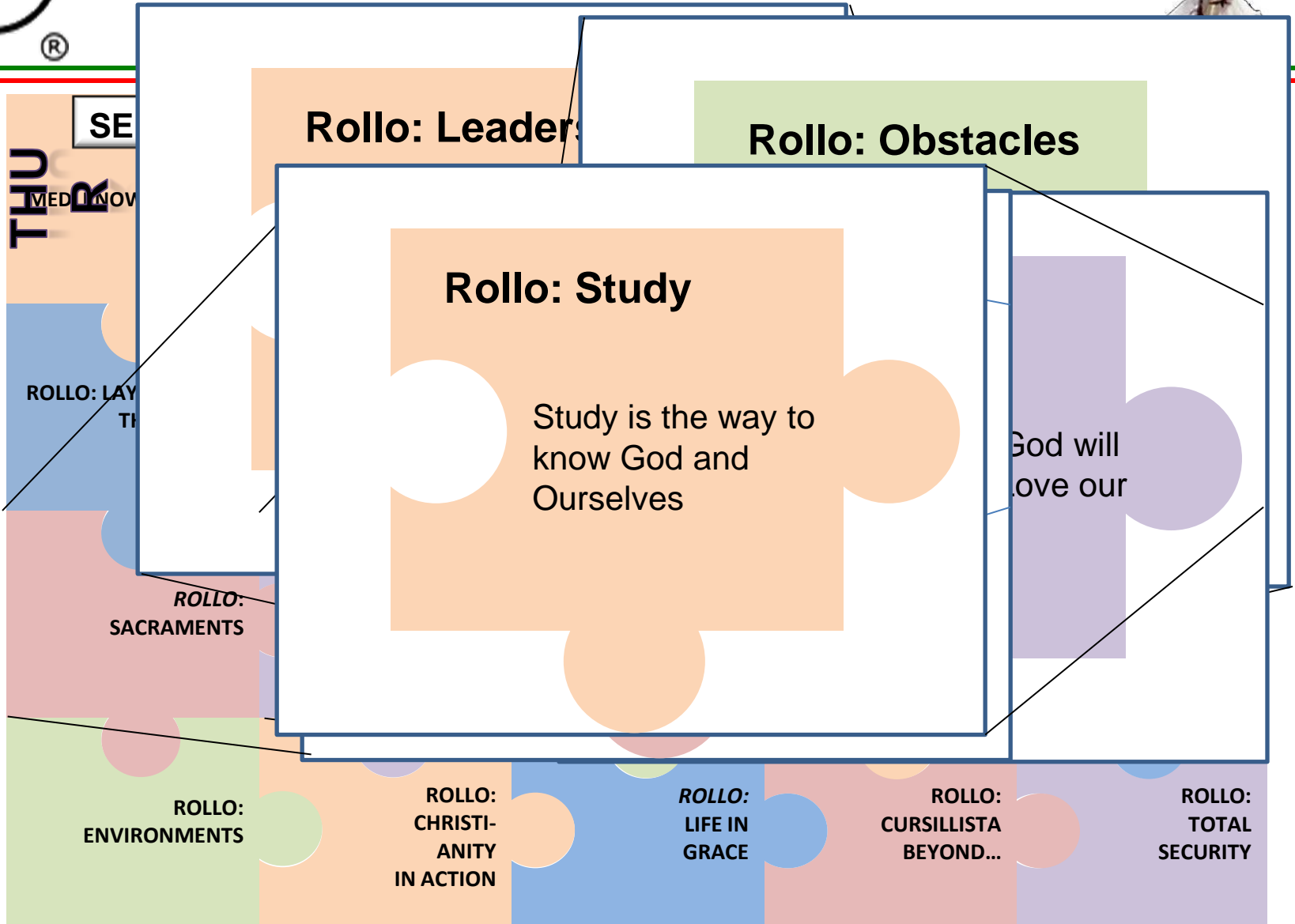
