- † Move away from us the tiny rivalries, sensitivities, discourtesies, pride, everything which distracts from You, everything which divides or discourages.




Leader's Prayer con't

Purpose of PostCursillo



The Postcursillo is designed to renew, accelerate and continue the conversion of each individual, and through that conversion, to provide a continuous transformation of the environments each individual encounters during daily life. *Postcursillo is about seeing Christ in every person and in every moment*.

Why?

So each Cursillista may become a means to transform society (vertebrae Christianity); while sharing in groups in order to encourage and sustain a more authentic, constant and progressive Christianity

How?

Through use of the tools of Group Reunion and Ultreya. These are designed to supplement and complement the Church community.



Authentic Postcursillo



An authentic Postcursillo provides the means for each person to persevere in striving to live out the Christian life—to become "fully alive" (St Irenaeus)

How?

By being mindful of both the individual and community aspects of Christian life

Goal is to BE more, not do more

Accomplish the vision presented during the Three Day Weekend by participation in Group Reunion and Ultreya

More effort should be put into the Postcursillo than into any other phase of the Movement, including the Three Day Weekend

To enable each of us to become more effective apostles and more Christlike each day



Grouping and Ultreya is Key



Grouping and Ultreya are the means through which individuals and the larger community are sustained, encouraged and challenged on the journey of progressive conversion (sanctification/holiness)

How?

By sharing the joys and trials of Christian life

To ensure attentiveness to all three encounters (piety, study and action)

Grouping is based upon friendship—those you "want" to group with—and the sharing of piety, study, action, "closest moment"

Ultreya is focused upon creating an environment in which we come to know our brothers and sisters as we walk together as a Christian community in action—those you "should" group with

Ultreyas should be *available* weekly and be comprised of the following elements--personal contact, floating group reunion, witness, prayer, and availability to spiritual direction



Signs that a Postcursillo is less than fully authentic



- † A lack of, or the same, leaders who are willing to serve the Movement
- † Misunderstanding that Cursillo is a special club that can only be shared with specific groups of people—i.e. those "mature in their faith"
- † A lack of study and desire to grow in understanding of the Cursillo charism
- † A belief that everyone should make a Cursillo—even if they are not qualified--i.e. those who can not receive the sacraments
- † More attention given to the Three Day Weekends than to Precursillo and/or Postcursillo
- † Misunderstood to be just another program or parish ministry or as a means to develop parish leaders
- † Focusing upon one encounter at the expense of the others—i.e piety and little study, action but little piety, etc



How Cursillistas can live an authentic 4th Day (Post-Cursillo)



- † Continue to deepen your Christian conversion in all three encounters—self, Christ and others
- Keep studying and growing in your understanding of the Cursillo charism and methodology
- † Ensure your fellow Cursillistas and candidates have a group. Invite him/her to your group if/when necessary
- † Regularly attend and invite your fellow Cursillistas to Ultreya and School of Leaders
- † Actively see candidates all the time: be a friend, make a friend, bring a friend to Christ
- † Be mindful that Christ is counting on you, so you must depend upon Him in all things by praying and offering palanca daily



Postcursillo Summary



- † Each person continues to discover and deepen friendships in each of the three encounters using the methodology of through Group Reunion and Ultreya
- † Environments encountered by Cursillistas are transformed to become more Christ-like
- † Cursillistas are a living proclamation of the best news that God in Jesus Christ loves us, and this news is communicated though friendship with the best end of each person—a person fully alive—as the goal
- † A Movement that understands the Cursillo charism and purpose, attracts others through its authenticity, and develops numerous leaders willing to serve within the Movement

Work of the Sections






Work of the Sections



- † Work of the Sections is designed to be the opportunity for the members of the School of Leaders to identify, design, and help implement solutions to any issues within the three sections--PreCursillo, Cursillo and PostCursillo
- † Work of the Sections is directed and conducted under the leadership and guidance of the current Secretariat member responsible for that section
- † SOL members count off and distribute evenly between the 3 sections—unless they are actively serving on a particular committee within a particular section (i.e. Palanca committee members work with the Precursillo section, Communications committee members work with PostCursillo, etc...)




Closing Prayer
