- † Move away from us the tiny rivalries, sensitivities, discourtesies, pride, everything which distracts from You, everything which divides or discourages.




Leader's Prayer con't

TECHNIQUE TALK

3-Day Cursillo Chair, aka "the Handler" – lots of coordination!

- After team qualified SoL members have been received from SoL chair and Secretariat approves recommended Rector/Rectora, then the action starts!
- Pre-Cursillo meets "the Cursillo" or Where the baton is passed! The opportunity is upon us to, introduce the method to make possible the true living out of a Christian's baptismal commitment.
- The weekend does not happen by chance, and let us never lose sight of the fact that, "It can be said that a Cursillo Weekend is the realistically joyful communication of being Christian." (page 91 of the Leaders Manual)



3- Day Chair cont



- The 3-Day Chair is the conduit between Pre-Cursillo and Team leaders, specifically the Rector/Rectora and Set-up Chief; working items like candidates with special needs, i.e. diets, disability accommodations, etc.
- These last five weekends have been more of a challenge than normal due to the new construction at Sacred Heart convent –candidate drop-off/pick-up, escorting to Clausura thank you for your patience
- Also the 3-Day Chair is the primary POC with the Retreat Center Director: any changes in dates, logistics, damage to the Retreat Center or dorms, etc. are communicated to the 3-Day chair



SOL 3-Day Cursillo to Post Cursillo



- There are redundancies built into our process, but PARAMOUNT is that the Sponsor has done his/her responsibilities!
- We "fall apart" when:
 - 1. there is no identified group for the new Cursillista(s) to go to **immediately after** the weekend
 - 2. New Cursillistas are not invited, <u>carried to and</u> <u>introduced</u> at the first available local Ultreya
- Cursillo Chair ensures that all new Cursillistas' updated contact information is relayed from the Set-up chief to the Post Cursillo chair, ensuring that communications to new Cursillistas are ongoing!

Work of the Sections






Work of the Sections




Closing Prayer
