The Secretariat



- † "The Secretariats exist to preserve the dynamic unity of the Cursillo Movement..." (FI#578)
- † "The Secretariats have as their foremost objective the inescapable duty of preserving, developing, actualizing and invigorating the mentality, the purpose and the basic core of methodology that defines and characterizes the Cursillo Movement as a Movement of the Church." (FI #582)



School of Leaders (SOL)



- † "The School is an instrument of apostolic outreach to people who have lived the experience of a Cursillo weekend. It helps them discover, accept, and grow in their vocations, bringing them together so that together they can take on the responsibility of being leaders in the Church, in the Movement and in their respective secular environments." (FI #532)
- † I don't come because I don't want to be a leader.

SOIL



- † "The School of Leaders is has a three fold role:
 - To be a school of holiness; (Piety)
 - To be a school of community, (Action) and
 - To be a school of formation. (Study)

The School is to the Ultreya what the team is to the 3-Day weekend. "Just as the team is what makes the Cursillo weekend possible, it is also a team that makes the Postcursillo possible." (FI #513)
