

Diocese of Birmingham in Alabama Cursillo Three Day Weekend Application

Sponsor Instructions:

When sponsoring a Candidate, remember: MAKE A FRIEND, BE A FRIEND, BRING A FRIEND TO CHRIST.

Sponsorship of a candidate is one of the most important contributions a Cursillista can make to the Movement. It is an action that should only be entered into after thorough and prayerful consideration.

Remember to talk to God about the Candidate before you talk to the Candidate about God.

One of the primary factors to consider regarding sponsorship is whether YOU are an active member of a Group Reunion. Since the Sponsor declares an intention to guide the new Cursillista for a year after they have attended a Three-Day weekend, the support of an active Group Reunion is essential. In addition, to ensure that a new Cursillista is given the support of the entire community, participation in Ultreya and the School of Leaders should be strongly encouraged as well, keeping in mind that there is nothing more powerful than the personal example of someone who is living out the Fourth Day.

If you are currently not grouping, seek out assistance of active Cursillista(s) to assist you in sponsoring as well as grouping with your candidate.

The following guidelines should help you in your selection of a suitable candidate.

A Candidate:

1. Must be eligible to receive the Sacraments.
2. Should be emotionally stable
3. Should have time to participate in Post Cursillo activities--Group Reunions, Ultreya, as well as other Fourth Day Activities.
4. Should be, or has the potential to be, a Christian leader within their day-to-day environment(s).

Keep in mind that whenever possible, couples should also be encouraged to apply *together*, and that the Three-Day weekend should be fully explained, but with an emphasis upon Fourth Day Activities. Also, *please* do not make any commitments to a prospective Candidate regarding making a weekend on a specific date(s) as this will avoid any possible disappointments. Finally, always remember that as a Sponsor your primary responsibility is to help prepare a candidate for perennial living out of the Cursillo in the Postcursillo.

Once a Candidate has returned the Candidate application to you, it is YOUR responsibility to fill out the Sponsor application as well as obtain the Pastor/Parish Administrator's Recommendation and Signature before mailing the *complete* candidate packet (consisting of the Candidate Application with deposit, Sponsor Form, and *signed* Pastor Recommendation Form) to the address listed below.
